May my story inspire others to open their hearts and homes to children in need, and may we all strive to create a world where every child has the opportunity to thrive in a safe and loving environment.

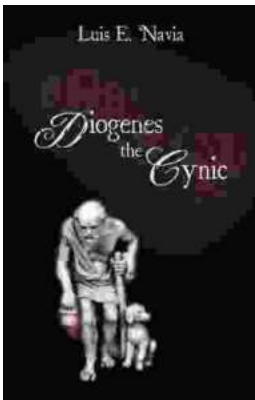


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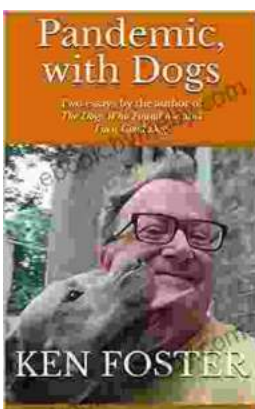
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
